<sup>1</sup>**Designated area:** means private property, a parking lot, a campground, an airport, a ferry terminal, a golf course or a marina.

<sup>2</sup>**Worksite:** location where vehicle is being used for the utility purpose for which it was designed; for a sidewalk sweeper or plow, the worksite is the continuous area beneath the vehicle being swept or plowed, but for all others, travelled portion of highway use limited to not more than 100 continuous meters.

<sup>3</sup>**Public works:** means operation of a motor vehicle owned, leased or rented by the Province, a municipality, a regional district, a transportation authority, a health authority or a school district for maintenance, landscaping or industrial purposes.

\*Utility vehicle operation in designated area or at university/college campus is limited to use by or on behalf of the owner/operator of the designated area or by or on behalf of the university or college.

\*\* Modified golf cart adapted for a utility purpose.
